

How to Set Up After Hours Post-Accident/Reasonable Suspicion Testing

Please **call** Noble Diagnostics at **(877) 200-5616** or **(262) 957-1968** to arrange the test.

Between the hours of 5:00 pm and 7:59 am, this will connect you to the drug and alcohol technician on call.

For all testing, please have the following information ready:

Company Information:

1. Company Name
2. Caller's Name and Callback Number
3. Company Location Donor Information:
 1. Donor's name
 2. Donor ID (if available)

Test Information:

1. Test type: DOT, nonDOT, or rapid
2. Tests: Drug or Alcohol or both
3. Test reason: reasonable suspicion, post accident, etc.

Testing Location:

- Where will the test be administered if not at company address?
- Special information (parking, door number, security, gate)

If the test is remote (not in the Milwaukee area), please provide this additional information:

Company Contact:

1. Name & phone number of supervisor in contact with donor (if different from caller):
2. Is or will the supervisor be with the donor?

Donor Contact:

1. Phone number of donor if necessary to coordinate testing location.

Test Information:

1. If DOT-reportable post accident:
 - a. Time of accident:
 - b. Reason for DOT report: Ticket & Tow, Ticket & Treatment away from scene, Fatality
2. Does the donor have testing supplies with him - cup, chain, or protocol?

Testing Location:

2. Donor's current location – city and state or zip code.
3. When will the donor be free to be tested?
4. Where would you prefer the donor be tested? At a medical facility or will a mobile collector be needed?

The on-call technician will begin their search to locate a mobile collector or medical facility to accommodate your drug and alcohol testing needs. They will be in touch with you every step of the way until the collections are completed. The next business day the technician will follow up with the mobile or medical facility to make sure the collection was completed and we have the paperwork.
